- Drive with your permit for 6 months and turn 16 (HAPPY BIRTHDAY!)
 - Complete your "Less Tears...More Years" Act 20-Hour Parent Log. (Remember, SafeWay offers Advanced Driving Packages that will satisfy these requirements while preparing you for today's roads.)
 - Make an appointment to take your DPS Driving Test. Go in person (with your parent or legal guardian) or schedule online (at www.txdps.state.tx.us). Contact your local DPS with any questions.
 - Bring these REQUIRED ITEMS with you when you go to the DPS:
 - Your Valid Learner's Permit
 - Your Original Birth Certificate
 - Your Original Social Security Card
 - DE-964 Certificate labeled "Driver License Only"
 - VOE (Verification of Enrollment) Form from your High School's Registrar's Office
 - \$11.00 Driver License Examination Fee (subject to change)
 - Street Legal Automobile with Proof of Insurance
 - Glasses or Contacts (if needed)
 - Parent
 - Remember to drive the SafeWay and ace your test!
 - Put your cell phone away and drive SAFE!
