- Complete your 3rd classroom/online session and pass the Permit Test.
 - Visit www.txdps.state.tx.us for DPS locations and hours.
 - Bring these **REQUIRED ITEMS** with you when you go to the DPS:
 - Your Original Birth Certificate
 - Your Original Social Security Card
 - EITHER your Student ID or Official Report Card
 - VOE (Verification of Enrollment) Form from your High School's Registrar's Office
 - Two Acceptable Forms of Texas Residency
 - Documents supporting Texas Residency must be in the name of the **parent** who shares your address and is taking you to the DPS
 - DE-964 Form provided by SafeWay Driving Centers
 - DL14a Application for License provided by the DPS office
 - \$16.00 Learner's Permit Fee (subject to change)
 - Glasses or Contacts (if needed)
 - Parent
